## Registration/Application - Important Information - Release and Terms

### DEPOSIT AND RESERVATIONS

Upon receipt of your \$1000 deposit SeaTrek will send you an email confirmation and/or contact you by phone to answer all additional questions you may have. With your confirmation you will receive your SeaTrek crew shirt, a clothing list, medical form, travel details and dive training forms. These forms contain important information about SeaTrek voyages so please take some time and go over them carefully. Forms and training materials must be filled out and returned within 7 business days. They must be signed by the participant and by the parents if the participant is a minor. SeaTrek must receive and review all forms before final acceptance into any voyage. Receipt of deposit constitutes a binding contract of participation.

All voyages are all-inclusive live-aboard experiences including sailing, diving, and marine biology instruction. Tuition pays for yacht charter cost, room & board, equipment usage, and excursions. Also included are four or more diving certifications (21 Day Program), island hopping and cultural experiences, hiking, water sports, and some surprise activities. The only things not included in the tuition price are spending money, plane tickets, and trip insurance.

**MEDICAL RELEASE** Participant and parent(s), including guardian(s) (hereafter 'guardian(s)') hereby give SeaTrek owners and their staff authority to provide or obtain medical care for participant. They are also authorized to transport participant by any means, as needed to obtain treatment. Medical consideration may comprise of the services of a medically licensed physician, prescribed medications, hospitalization, and surgical procedures. It is hereby understood that SeaTrek has no fiscal responsibility for the medical care provided and participant and guardian(s), shall assume responsibility for any and all costs affiliated with such care. Examples of cost may be medical evacuation, treatment or prescriptions, as well as any possible cost that may come about for transportation, meals, accommodations, and expenses for SeaTrek staff assigned to the student. It shall also be understood that medical services and their facilities in foreign countries may be substandard as compared to medical facilities in the US, and may not be as available and accessible as similar facilities in the United States.

**MODEL RELEASE** This release guarantees SeaTrek, and their assignees, the exclusive use of photos, videos and recordings taken with SeaTrek equipment or on a SeaTrek voyage. These photos, videos, and recordings may or may not include the participant and allow SeaTrek exclusive use of this media in any form that it sees fit including advertising, website content, educational, audiovisual, and any other company use.

### BALANCE, INSURANCE, & TERMS

A \$1000 deposit (non-refundable) is required to secure a berth on a SeaTrek voyage. Once you have deposited a berth you are responsible for full program payment whether you participate or not. One-half of your remaining program balance is due February 1, 2010. The remaining balance of tuition is due on or before March 15th, 2010. If signing up after March 15th, a berth is only guaranteed when the full tuition is paid. If the balance is not received by this date, berths may be canceled with no return of deposit, fees paid or fees due. SeaTrek offers no return of fees for non-arrivals, early withdrawal or berth cancellation. There will be a \$100 late fee imposed for every 7-calendar days that payment is in default. Prices shown reflect a 3% cash discount. Three percent of the program cost will be added to fees paid by credit card. Student and guardian(s) hereby agree that if said student is released or departs the voyage under any circumstance, or departs early from any voyage, no fees will be returned, including any fees paid for a later SeaTrek voyage. We understand there are extenuating circumstances so we strongly urge you to protect your investment by purchasing trip insurance. Most policies do not cover this type of activity so information for trip specific insurance is included for you when you sign up. Personal dive insurance is required for participants to dive with SeaTrek. This insurance is very affordable and available through Diver's Alert Network (DAN) for a minimal price. Participant and guardian(s) are responsible for all costs of early departure whatever the reason. Possible costs may include, but may not be limited to medical costs, plane, taxi, meals, accommodations, and expenses for SeaTrek staff accompanying the participant. Remember that you are leaving your country of origin and therefore must have a passport.

### STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

Participants should expect a summer of hands-on high adventure. Most activities take place on and around our live-aboard yachts. Please arrive with the understanding that you are members of the crew, and are responsible for daily activities and handling of vessels including helmsmanship, sail trimming, chef duties, boat cleaning and more. Do not mistake this adventure for a pampered vacation. Follow all staff instructions during all activities. We enforce a strict Zero-Tolerance policy during all voyages. Any use of non-prescription drugs (unless approved by a SeaTrek director prior to departure), alcohol, or tobacco products is strictly prohibited. The directors reserve the right to dismiss anyone who in his or her judgment violates this policy or safe diving procedures, or is deemed to be detrimental to the program. All Treks are non-competitive and participants are expected to show respect and consideration for their fellow crew. Ample sleeping areas are provided in the form of shared cabins and other covered sleeping areas. Waterproof hammocks are provided for those wishing to sleep under the stars.

By signing below I hereby warrant that I have read and understand these terms. I also agree to adhere to all SeaTrek standards of conduct. I understand that my connection with SeaTrek Ltd. will be governed by Michigan State law and that any mediation, suit, or other dispute I may have with SeaTrek, must be filed or entered into only in the State of Michigan. In any action, decision, or judgment upholding SeaTrek's position, the opposing party will reimburse SeaTrek's attorney fees and court expenses where reasonable.
